Dear Modesto Christian School Families and Friends,

We continue to be thankful

As we approach another "Giving Tuesday" in the midst of the ongoing COVID-19 challenges, it is humbling to think about the many ways God has provided for Modesto Christian School's most urgent needs this past year. For that and many other things we continue to be thankful!

We continue to have needs

Modesto Christian School also continues to experience financial needs above and beyond our normal, budgeted operating expenses. As a school board we try to prioritize non-budgeted items that are needed to keep MC operating safely and to provide your students and our teachers with the best tools possible to provide excellence in education. The school administration has put forward two such needs that we are prayerfully asking you to consider supporting with your year-end giving.

- **Elementary Campus - Complete the Curriculum.** Last year MC deployed a new, rigorous, knowledge-based curriculum in our elementary school starting with Kindergarten, 1st Grade, and 2nd Grade. It is a wonderful curriculum that we want to continue deployment in 3rd through 5th Grades. It will cost approximately \$20,000 to complete this curriculum for our entire K-5 elementary campus.
- **High School / Middle School Campus - Safety Considerations.** The High School campus has had a number of great facility improvements in the past few years, but an important safety concern is the decades-old sidewalks that pass through the campus. There are a number of areas where tree roots or seasonal flooding have raised, lowered, and broken up sidewalks to the point of creating safety hazards around the campus. A number of students and teachers have tripped and had minor injuries as a result of this condition so we need to resolve it before more serious injuries occur. In addition, the high school parking lot traffic flows have exposed a need for concrete traffic barriers to protect pedestrians from potential injuries. While the total cost of repairing all of the sidewalks and barriers is estimated to be more than \$25,000, we would be able to get a good start with the most critical areas for \$10,000 - \$15,000.

We know that our current MC families already make financial sacrifices for tuition and additional giving may not be possible at this time. That's OK! We are very grateful to you for choosing Modesto Christian School for your children's education. For families and friends of MC that do have the ability to give, we are asking for your help. Thank you for considering this in your year-end giving and thank you for your continued prayers and support of Modesto Christian School!
