AP STUDENTS

As you begin to prepare yourself for AP Exams in May, please be aware of the following:

- Review the 2021 AP Exam Terms & Conditions
- You are required to arrive 30 minutes prior to your exam
 - o 8 AM Exam: Arrive at 7:30 am
 - 12 PM Exam: Arrive at 11:30 am
 - o Doors will be closed and locked at 8 am
- You are not required to attend school on the day of your AP exam. If you have a morning exam, you may leave once you are dismissed from the exam. If you have an afternoon exam, you must arrive 30 minutes before the exam
- Review the <u>What to Bring on Exam Day</u> article from CollegeBoard
- · Review the Calculator Policy
- Get a good night's rest before your exam, and eat a nutritious breakfast. You are allowed to bring a snack and beverage for your 10-minute break. However, food and drink are prohibited in the exam room. It is advisable to bring a sweater, in case the room temperature is below your comfort level.
- If you play a sport or have a job, it is your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP Exam obligation, and arrangements should be made accordingly.


