



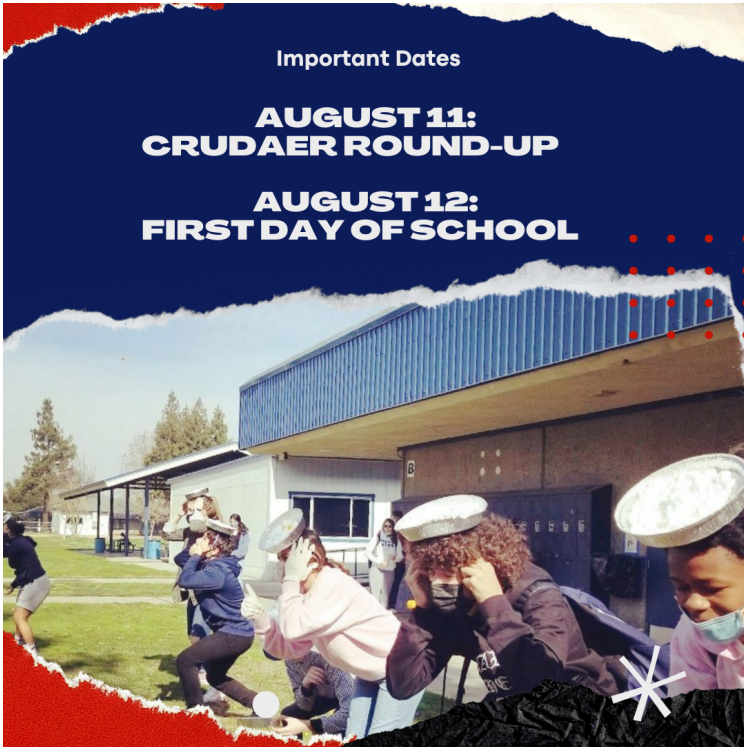

## Safe and Healthy Learning Environment

Modesto Christian School will continue to follow important measures to ensure our students and their families, and our employees are safe. The faculty and staff will adhere to cleaning and disinfection procedures for classrooms, restrooms, offices and other common areas.

We are asking all students and parents/guardians to be diligent in monitoring your student's health on a daily basis. To ensure the health and welfare for our MCS family, please keep the following in mind:

- Stay home from work or school when sick. Remain home until you are fever free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medicines
- Seek medical care if symptoms become more severe (high fever or difficulty breathing)
- Wash hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If water is not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer (hand sanitizer and wipes are in every classroom)
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, mouth with unwashed hands
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then dispose of the tissue properly
- Clean and disinfect touched objects and surfaces
- Avoid contact with those who are sick.
