It is important to distinguish behavior that rises to the level of bullying from behaviors that indicate rudeness or mean behavior:

Rude = inadvertently saying or doing something that hurts someone else.

Mean = purposefully saying or doing something to hurt someone once (or maybe twice).

**Bullying** = cruel behavior, done on purpose and repeated over time that involves an imbalance of power.

Make no mistake; mean and rude behaviors can wound deeply and adults can make a huge difference in the lives of young people when they hold kids accountable. Yet, meanness and being rude is different from bullying in important ways that should be understood and differentiated when it comes to intervention.

If you witness bullying, you have the power to stop it. How?

Advocacy skills!

<u>Self Advocate</u>: You have the right to identify what you need and to ask for help. You are not alone.

Advocate for others: If it feels safe to do so, ask that the bullying stop or find an adult who can quickly intervene
