We miss seeing you and look forward to our students returning to campus along with our faculty and staff on Monday, October 26th. While our MC community has been off campus for this time period, all classrooms have received a deep cleaning and been sanitized to ensure that we have a healthy environment for students to learn.

### ***HVAC Bi-Polar Ionization System***

Through the generous donation of AllCare Physicians Medical Group, installation of the HVAC Ultra-Violet System will be retrofitted to our current systems in each classroom and completed before students return on Monday. This system uses proactive air purification technology and is a proven method of destroying viruses.

### ***Stanislaus County Update***

The correspondence from Stanislaus County indicates that if our county remains in the red tier through the week, we will actually be able to return fully in-person and on-campus. We will continue to monitor the statistics carefully and be prepared for all campuses to return to school fully on October 26th.

If the county returns to the purple tier, MCS students in grades K-6 will return to campus under the approved Waiver and preschool will return under California licensing. Students in grades 7-8 will return under our cohorts, and grades 9-12 will return on campus under the On-Campus Hybrid Program. We will keep you updated as we learn more from the county.

Parent/Teacher Conferences were conducted last week. If you were unable to participate in the parent conferences, please know teachers are always available for a phone conference and email conversation until meetings on-campus are encouraged. Your student's academic progress is important and a priority to MC!
